Your CUPE bargaining team met with the employer today expecting a meaningful proposal at the bargaining table. Unfortunately, the employer came back to the table with **no new offer**.

CUPE is fighting for a fair deal and better working conditions for health care workers, and we continue to prepare for our strike deadline of October 8th. Going on strike is a last resort, and we understand it is very stressful for all members.
